TVR® — SERIES 1 LIMITED EDITION VINTAGE 1993

TVR® explores a super rare 8mm acetate material kept since 1993 for its latest limited edition collection.

Within its first year, TVR® Series 1 Collection has garnered overwhelming response and demand worldwide. Following its success, TVR® will be releasing an exclusively limited edition batch using a super rare material kept in its warehouse since 1993.

The Vintage 1993 8mm acetate material, available in two colour variations, is one of the most-desired material in the French eyewear industry dating back to 1950s. The discovery was made by one of TVR®'s master craftsmen, and due to the limited quantity, only 99 pieces will be produced for each colour.

The colour variations include Vintage Black Clear and Vintage Brown Clear. The effect is an elegant two-tone contrast that's almost like a browline but straddling along a colour-blocking finish. Paired with the classical archival French vintage design with an overarching Crown Panto archetype, the unique collection is a fine example of 'East meets West' where one will experience Japanese hand-crafted artistry combined with European design silhouette.

This must-have collection is also made using the last batch of the vintage material, only available for this time only. Each eyepiece will also be marked with a serial number from 01/99 to 99/99, complementing the intricate Japanese 'The Great Wave of Kanagawa' engraving on the gold core of the eyepiece.

“I want you to pay attention at the Japanese engraving on the gold core of the eyepiece. It depicts detailing from Kanagawa-oki nami ura (The Great Wave off Kanagawa). I'd like to dedicate this to all the Japanese artisans out there.” — TVR® Master Craftsman





TVR® Series 1 is also loved for its delicate artistry comprising the diamond cut technique, a 90-degree edge without curved angles forming its main structure; and the diamond edge finishing that's perfected by hand by legendary master craftsmen. The flat front without rivets also fashions a clean and minimalistic look with its thick frame balanced by wide library temples tapping to flared tips. The excellent polishing process also enables the eyepiece to possess an unparalleled handmade quality unlike any other.

“You can say that the polishing skill is based on my ‘sixth sense’ because it is entirely based on what you see and how you feel. There are a lot of attention into detail involved in the making of this collection,” explains the mastermind behind this collection.
