Based on the iconic JD shape frame, the model is meticulously recreated by hand by our expert craftsmen in Sabae, Japan; including 50s retro anti-slip strips, seven-barrel hinges, keyhole bridge, signature SPM (Sun Platinum Metal) spear rivets and miter cutting by hand.

Miter cut is a critical technique vintage eyewear where the frontal frame and legs each lie at a 45-degree angle, creating a 90-degree angle. True Vintage Revival remakes all the original elements of the TVR^* 504 using the exceptionally rare, authentic mould that produced this classic shape that has been worn by many illustrious icons of the century.

To celebrate the overwhelming support and encouraging response from customers over the years, TVR* OPT will be offering this 2021 EDITION using Zylonite material, featuring the intricate Japanese engraving depicting The Great Wave of Kanagawa on the metal core in this classic frame that comes with a modern twist.



What is SPM (Sun Platinum Metal)?

SPM is a precious metal allow developed by Shintaro Kato in 1930 in Japan. It was a very rare commodity at that time and beloved by the Showa royal family for its hardiness, resistance against corrosion and excellent skin compatibility. Hence, the export of raw SPM material was not allowed back then. Its remarkable characteristics have made SPM the best material for eyewear frames as well as dental accessories and tools for cosmetic surgeries. Despite the name, SPM doesn't contain platinum — instead, it refers to the soft platinum colour after it has been polished. More importantly, the material retains its beautiful lustre even after a long period of time.
